

We are recruiting for the position of Director, Office of Civil Enforcement (OCE), in EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance Assurance. This is a Senior Executive Service (SES) position located in Washington, DC.

The Director of Civil Enforcement is a member of EPA's senior management team, and leads an office of four divisions (Air, Water, Waste/Chemicals, and Special Litigation/Projects) made up of 144 employees. The OCE Director is a national leader of the civil enforcement program, and supervises the development of federal civil enforcement cases in both the judicial and administrative areas. The Director advises senior Agency leadership on enforcement matters that present the highest risks to human health and the environment, and develops legal strategies to address these problems. The Director also coordinates with the EPA program offices on national policy issues and rulemakings that implicate enforcement, and coordinates with the EPA Regional Offices to ensure effective targeting and case development. By maintaining a vigorous enforcement program, the organization deters violations, eliminates financial incentives to noncompliance, and promotes a level playing field among regulated entities.
