

## POLICE CHIEF

The **City of Corpus Christi, Texas** (Population 305,215) is seeking an energetic, self-driven and results-oriented municipal law enforcement professional to serve as its next Chief of Police. Corpus Christi is located about 140 miles southeast of San Antonio on Corpus Christi Bay, an inlet off the Gulf of Mexico. The community boasts the 5<sup>th</sup> largest seaport in the United States by tonnage, and is a center for petrochemical manufacturing, large-scale fabrication, marine research, maritime shipping, and tourism. The City government has a staff of approximately 3,400 employees, including 451 sworn and 266 civilian personnel in the Police Department. Divisions within the Police Department include: Community Policing, Special Services, Communications, Criminal Investigation, Professional Standards, Crime Prevention, Organized Crime, Training and Administration.
